BEFORE: COMBS, DYCHE, AND KNOPF, JUDGES.

DYCHE, JUDGE: Beverly and Daniel Dezarn were married in June 1964, separated in November 1998, and Beverly petitioned for dissolution in that same month. After twenty-three hearings before the domestic relations commissioner, the parties finally reached a settlement agreement. However, not all matters were resolved to each party's satisfaction, and they were unable to cooperate on the actual execution of the agreement. The commissioner filed his report on November 15, 2000. Both parties

filed exceptions, which the trial court overruled, confirming and adopting the commissioner's report on February 8, 2001.

Beverly appeals, arguing that she should have been given appropriate credit for Daniel's dissipation of certain marital assets. She further contends that the valuation of marital assets was erroneous. We have examined the record in its entirety and discern no error in the commissioner's findings, and the trial court's adoption thereof, regarding dissipation and valuation. Kentucky Rules of Civil Procedure 53.06(2) and 52.01; Brown v. Brown, Ky., 462 S.W.2d 201 (1970). Beverly's arguments have been thoroughly considered and rejected for the third time.

The judgment of the Grant Circuit Court is affirmed.
