McANULTY, JUDGE. Gregory Campbell appeals his conviction following his plea of guilty to rape in the first degree. Campbell's attorney filed a brief in support of his motion to withdraw as counsel of record pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S. Ct. 1396, 18 L. Ed. 2d 493 (1967) which was granted on December 13, 2001. Campbell did not file a *pro se* supplemental brief.

We have reviewed the Anders brief and the responsive brief of the Commonwealth. We agree that pursuant to

Bordenkircher v. Hayes, 434 U.S. 357, 98 S. Ct. 663, 54 L. Ed. 2d 604 (1978) there is no valid issue for consideration on appeal. Furthermore, Campbell has waived his right to an appeal by his guilty plea. Accordingly, the judgment of the Campbell Circuit Court is affirmed.
