DYCHE, JUDGE. Edward Earl Stover appeals from the denial of his CR 60.02 motion for correction of his sentence for three counts of rape, for which he received three life sentences, without the possibility of parole. He was convicted and sentenced under pre-Penal Code statutes.

Mr. Stover had extensively litigated this issue in both the courts of this Commonwealth and the United States

Courts. The issue he raises herein has previously been decided adversely to him; nothing new is presented in the present petition or appeal. The order of the Jefferson Circuit Court is affirmed.
