### OPINION

### AFFIRMING

BEFORE: DYCHE, GUIDUGLI, AND McANULTY, JUDGES.

DYCHE, JUDGE: Demetrius Williams was arrested for drug-related offenses in Christian County on March 5, 2002. The Circuit/District Clerk's office opened case number 02-F-186 following his arrest; several people joined together to post a cash bond of \$50,000 to secure his release. On April 26, 2002, the grand jury indicted Williams on the same charges; this indictment was assigned case number 02-CR-00120 in the circuit court. He was allowed to remain at large on the bond previously posted.

Williams apparently had other drug-related problems and an arrest resulting from those problems; and, although we have nothing in the record to verify this, a \$9,000.00 bond was apparently posted to secure Williams's release on these charges (thought to be case number 02-CR-00516). This bond was apparently forfeited or in some manner transferred to the United States District Court, and therein lies the problem about which Williams complains.

Unfortunately for Williams, the \$9,000.00 or its whereabouts have nothing to do with the present case and its proceedings. That money is a part of a completely different charge and criminal prosecution. Even if Williams's contentions have any merit we are without jurisdiction over them; the only case involved in this appeal is number 02-CR-00120. Williams has apparently appealed in the wrong case.

The order of the Christian Circuit Court is affirmed.
